



If you prefer a more classical game, you have the option to go wild boar hunting. In New Zealand the tradition is to hunt with a knife.






Michael Campbell & his wife have renewed their vows at beautiful Pink Beach (which is made of millions of tiny pink shells)


You can enjoy the magnificent view while having breakfast or lunch.


The Infinity pool has also a breathtaking view of the ocean.
